3. Budget 2022 - comments

- Beyond project: allocation of \$10,000
- Small Grants Program: allocation of \$20,000 in grants between now and December.
- fee support donations and most costs are as per 2021 budget
- copyright protection the budget is for \$4,000 to conclude registration of the trademark and to pay for work completed on our application for copyright.

4. Executive Director's report, January 2022

- annual statistics and analysis see the separate report
 - 1% decline in total numbers, plus maybe more who are in arrears
 - this is very positive, in the context of the pandemic
 - o numbers in NA are down, in WW numbers are up
 - o numbers in UK are down (the network is currently less active than before)
 - there has been an increase in fee support
- <u>LG fee collection and reminders</u> going well: thank you, Martha! DUP UK still has no administrator and no apparent current activity.
- <u>copyright infringement</u>: we are waiting for trademark registration to be completed. Our copyright application has been rejected for the second time. The Board voted not to contest this decision. We will update aspects of the website, to emphasise custom and practice, not legal ownership of copyright.
- <u>40th anniversary of the start of the Dances:</u> Saadi and Tasnim held a zoom webinar on Jan 29. Up to 450 people attended simultaneously. This event was translated into German, Spanish and Russian.
- <u>newsletters</u> have been circulated in several languages for the global online events in December and January.
- <u>fee support</u>: last year we were seeking donations for a \$3,000 fee support fund. In 2021 we spent 12% more on fee support, and the number of leaders supported increased by 7%, mainly in the Americas. We received donations of \$1380 in response to our November mailing, towards a total for the year of \$3122.32.
- <u>dance write-ups</u>: about 50 dance write-ups are being added in Portuguese, English and German; the Portuguese ones represent a dance leader training by Maria Lalla a few years ago. Thank you to Wayne Rollack and Sky Ratcliffe who have volunteered to help with formatting dance write-ups. If you have translations of much-loved dances, or original 'juicy' dances that you feel will reach far and wide, please check the <u>guidelines for</u> <u>submitting dance write-ups</u> and send them to Aziz Dixon, Executive Director, for the resource library.



5. Board vacancies

The Board endorsed the recommendation of the Nominations Committee to appoint Yelena Dudarjoka to the Board at the next Annual Meeting.

6. Small Grants Program

The Grants Manager reports:

We have started cycle 2, which runs to December 2022. Some grants have already been made this year.

We are continuing to find the best ways to set up international payments made by the Grants Manager from the relevant account.

The Board began a process of reviewing our investment program for the funds received from OP, starting by discussing the values underpinning our fiscal responsibilities.

7. Beyond initiative 2022

The Dec 2 zoom meeting on spiritual bypass was attended by nearly 300 people. A dance leader training event for Beyond will be held over Easter 2022 at Atlantida.
