We are grateful to have received a donation of some Tesla shares, for the benefit of the Beyond program. The 10 shares received by December 31 are shown as assets in the balance sheet. We plan to hold them until the value rises, and to review the share value at each Board meeting.

Net Income

#### Comments on the year-end financial results - 2022 actuals compared to budget

We budgeted to make a deficit of \$4,000, corresponding to the expenditure on legal fees for copyright work. In fact, we made a surplus of \$1,916.56, after allowing for prior year revenue to cover the planned Small Grants Program and Beyond Initiative.

Donations to the Beyond Initiative were significantly above budget – attributed to fundraising by Arjun in December.

LG fees were above budget, reflecting new leaders registered in the last quarter of the year from around the world.

We needed less input from our valued tech designer than budgeted, with fewer significant website changes this year.

Office expenditure was lower than budgeted - Martha's new computer will be purchased this year instead of in 2022.

Small Grants Program expenditure was well within budget, with lower disbursements than budgeted, and we now have a clearer baseline for budgeting for this activity for 2023. The budget for the Beyond Initiative in 2022, revised in April, was \$15,000, but only just over \$10,000 was needed.

### 3. Executive Director's report, January 2023

#### budget for 2023

The budget for 2023 is included in the profit and loss statement, above. It can also be found on our website here: https://www.dancesofuniversalpeace.org/dupmission.shtm.

Last year's actuals inform this year's budget, with the following additional comments.

1. Donations to Beyond initiative. We are budgeting for donations of \$5,000. Some of the donations sought in December feature in the accounts for last year (2022).

#### 2. Revenue prior year

The plan presented here is that we will allocate \$15,000 from prior year to the Beyond Initiative: this corresponds roughly to designated funds for Beyond plus planned donations allocated to the Initiative.

The plan is to spend \$25,700 on the Small Grants program, including staff costs.

- 3. Contract and employee labor: increases were agreed by the Board at the last meeting.
- 4. Equipment this is the first time in decades that Martha will have had a new computer.
- 5. A slight increase is budgeted for transfer fees for the Small Grants Program, to allow for transactions in a variety of countries.

Arjun, Rukmini and Martha agreed with the proposed budgets for their activities. NurAna moved approval of the budget, seconded by Munira, approved unanimously.

#### annual statistics

We now have leaders in 50 countries.

Most of the increase in numbers has been in the Worldwide region (showing the effect of the Beyond Initiative).

Totals have not obviously been affected by the pandemic.

The amount of fee support requested has declined slightly.

- **LG fee collection and reminders** going well: thank you, Martha!
- **copyright, trademarks:** a new logo policy is in preparation in light of the recent trademark determination.

and gives detail under these headings. Our brokerage account is already making it easier for someone to donate shares to us, and donations can be for DUP IN in general or for specific purposes such as the Beyond Initiative.

It was noted in discussion that seeking bequests is quite separate from other fund-raising. It was agreed that a video explaining about making bequests would be valuable, and Aziz will follow this up.

## 4. Small Grants Program

Update – January 2023

The Small Grants Program is off to a running start with Cycle 3 that opened on January 2nd. Since the beginning of the month, we have received four grant applications: two from India and one each for projects in Morocco and Mallorca. A wonderful way to begin the New Year.

We will be paying more attention to sustainability this year, asking grant applicants to elaborate on their plans to grow their DUP communities beyond their initial event. We plan to add a few more questions to the application or create a short form that will encourage applicants to consider how they may keep event participants engaged and interested in the Dances of Universal Peace longer term.

Also new this year, is a 2-grant limit per applicant per cycle. Due to multiple applications being submitted by a handful of mentored leaders/event organizers during Cycle 2, we have decided to aim for even more fairness, representation and balance. We also need to maintain a manageable workload for the committee members.

We are considering an inspired suggestion made by Arjun. He has encouraged us to create a promotional video for the Small Grants Program similar to the wonderful one recently produced by the Beyond Initiative. He reminded us of how powerful and helpful it could be to have grant recipients record brief testimonials about their experience with the SGP and highlight the beautiful events that are happening all over the world with the Program's support. Thanks for your continued interest. May 2023 be an illuminating and enriching year for all of us and our DUP global family!

## 5. Beyond Initiative 2022

Here is a recent report from Arjun: Dear friends of the BoD,

It is a pleasure to inform you that the Asian Planting Season DUP Tour is over and has been very successful.

After 2 month and a half of constant movement, 25 dancing days in 16 different locations in India, Vietnam, Indonesia, Maldives and Thailand, we closed with a 3-day camp at Gaia Ashram with delegations from all the countries visited plus future organizers of new countries to enter the program in 2023 (Korea, Japan, Malasia, Philippines).

There is an amazing group of talented young dance leaders starting their training and committed to keep the practice alive until next year activities. DUP have proven to have important medicine for all these countries and are taking roots very fast. After 4 years of work in the Middle East we have strong dance leaders and circles in the region and the first certifications happening. 2023 will see the scaling up of the work in Asia with our first training camp and caravan (Vietnam) and new countries entering the program, plus the first steps of the Beyond Initiative in Africa (starting in the Mediterranean north).

In addition, Arjun has written a manual for Beyond, explaining the methodology. This is particularly useful to share with people who may be interested in doing something similar, but without the background in this particular project. It will be uploaded to the website on this page: https://dancesofuniversalpeace.org/wwbeyond.shtm.

Arjun has suggested that a new video would be useful, as a way of explaining DUP to new audiences. A video is already available on the web page <u>About the Dances</u>. Arjun will propose a plan for the new video.

#### 6. Guidance Council

Arjun is contacting the Guidance Council about a proposed series of video encounters involving Guidance Council members and elders in our dance family, as a tribute to long service dance leaders and an inspiration and training resource for us all.
