#### 2. Minutes of the Board Meeting held May 10, 2023

The Board met and agreed parameters for a search committee for the selection of a new Executive Director, following the resignation in December this year of Aziz Dixon; also, to meet on June 20 to progress a vision for the next phase of the organization.

## 3. Minutes of the Board meeting held on June 20, 2023

The Board met and agreed the nomination of Arjun as President of the Board. Arjun asked for further clarification about the relationship between the Beyond initiative and the Board before accepting the role. The Board also discussed training for new members, and committee structures for developing organizational strategy and the active involvement of Board members.

Subsequently on June 26, Arjun declined to take on the role as President, and Darvesha agreed to continue as President.

Rukmini moved acceptance of the minutes for these meetings, seconded by NurAna, approved unanimously.

# 4. Executive Director appointment

The Board approved unanimously by email on July 30 the Search Committee's recommendation to appoint Carlos Rojas as Executive Director, starting on September 1; also a budget adjustment to cover a period of handover as Aziz is available up to Dec 31 as Co-Director to facilitate the best possible induction for Carlos.

# 5. 2021 Financial Reports: to the end of August 2023

Comments on the financial results:

Core activity is broadly as budgeted. The main change since the last report is a very generous donation of shares, some of which are allocated to the Beyond program, some not allocated to a specific project. The intention is to keep these as shares until a favorable market price prevails and until the Board decides we need to cash them in.

## 6. Executive Director's report

As well as facilitating the recruitment of the new Executive Director, Aziz has worked in committee with Darvesha and Munira to clarify that the caravans associated with the Beyond Initiative are legally entirely separate from the Beyond Initiative: The Beyond initiative is a project for which DUP International is responsible. Arjun Calero is the project coordinator. The caravans are the financial responsibility of the organizer, either Arjun Calero or another named individual. The documentation on our website has been updated to convey this with clarity. We aim to demonstrate best practice of the <u>US National Network of Fiscal Sponsors</u>.

#### 7. Small Grants Program: update – August 2023

To note: Rukmini will contact Oneness Project about whether money was intended for Beyond as well as for the Small Grants program.

#### Current grant cycle

The third cycle of the Small Grants Program opened on January 1, 2023. The first six months of the year were very busy. The submission of applications has slowed significantly during the past

few months. So far this year, we have received a total of 34 applications. All but two of those have been approved, and those two are pending as we await further details and budget information from the applicants.

A wide variety of projects and countries are represented in the Cycle 3 applications: Brazil, Chile, Colombia, The Czech Republic, Ecuador, France, Germany, India, Iran, Maldives, Morocco, New Zealand, Portugal, Spain, Turkey, Wales and three from the United States. The majority of projects/applicants received \$500 USD. Two awards were for approximately half that amount to cover annual Zoom subscriptions.

## Oneness Project awards

In early July, the Oneness Project announcement a cycle of grant awards of up to \$5,000. Since then, our program has seen a marked decline in applications. In fact, we have received only three applications since the OP's announcement. It is unclear whether the two are related but it seems possible. Shortly after the OP's announcement, we received several inquiries from previous grant recipients requesting clarification about "DUPIN's \$5,000 grants." Although the OP's announcement was clear to me, it appears to have created some confusion for others. Now that the OP's submission deadline has passed (August 15<sup>th</sup>), perhaps we will experience a return to a steadier rate of submissions. I will keep you posted.

#### Plans for a video

As some of you may recall, we previously discussed hiring a videographer to produce a short, promotional video for the Small Grants Program. The recent, significant drop in applications and the possible confusion caused by the Oneness Project's grant announcement leads me to believe that now is a good time to begin work on this project. We don't want the DUP family to forget about us and the contribution our grants have been making! The estimate to produce a short, promotional video is in the range of \$600-800. The small Grants Program has this amount available in our operating budget. It will not interfere with funds available for grant awards. I have spoken with Arjun about his success with promotional videos, and have invited Douglas to share any professional guidance he would like to offer. If any other board members are experienced in this area, please feel free to contact me.

I know that most of you have been/are traveling to Dances of Universal Peace events around the world. I pray for safe, smooth travels and an abundance of joy, connection, and inspiration in the various circles you encounter.
